

PRESCRIPTIONS FOR RAW MILK

At a meeting among David Lynch (owner of Guidestone Farm), Jim Dean (its counsel), and Barbara Hruska, Patti Klocker and Dan Trimberger (Consumer Protection Division, Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment) on March 1, 2004, Ms Hruska stated she had never seen a prescription for raw milk.

To illustrate they do exist, we are providing copies of two prescriptions issued to two Colorado residents who are Guidestone Farm cow share owners. One prescription is from a Colorado doctor and the other from a doctor in Illinois.

By specific provision of law, raw goat milk has been permitted to residents in the States of Kentucky and Rhode Island with a written prescription from a licensed medical doctor.
